


Thank you so much for your generous gift of £172.50, raised at your recent Bingo Night and for intending to hold another one in February. On behalf of the communities we work with, I'd like to express our sincere gratitude. Adana told us, "I had to go to the river at least three times a day for water. Each trip would take an hour, so three hours a day was spent just collecting water. We got sick often, especially my children".

For the community of Birnin Gaye a water pump has been installed providing a reliable source of water. This has not only improved the health of the community but means less children have to miss schools to help their families with water collections. Adana said, "I have more time and can make some extra money. All my school age children are in school now. I used to have to keep them home to help me. Since the well I have more time to rest, the children don't feel sick, and I am able to make things better for my family".

Once again, thank you very much for your assistance. Together we are making a big difference.
